The gymnasium is also going through a major renovation, including brand new flooring, wall padding, new doors, painting of the ceiling & walls as well as updated lighting. There will also now be a supply room accessible from the gym and updates to the locker rooms.

Secure entries are being done at the schools, these entry ways will be used to ensure no unauthorized access to the building. They will include bullet proof glass walls with a window to speak with the office administrator. At that point a visitor will need to be buzzed into the building if access is needed.
