Today's Program/Speaker info:

We were joined by Jeramy Clingerman, Superintendent of Seneca Falls School District, and he gave a presentation on the Capital Project.

The project includes upgrades at Cady Stanton, Frank Knight, Middle School and Mynderse as well as the bus garage. Improvements include:

Cady Stanton-New parking lot with improved lighting, new sidewalk from front of the school to the gym, providing window treatments to the cafeteria and gym and restroom renovations.

Frank Knight-Replace AC unit in the library and office.

Middle School-Renovations of the restrooms near the gym.

Mynderse-Renovate gym, renovate 6 science classrooms, theater lighting & carpet renovation, replacement of 2 hot water tanks.

All schools-CO2 detection system

Middle School/Mynderse-construct secure entrances.

The budget for the project was approved by voters in 2017, however, the bids for the project have come in over the original budget. This means the School District will need to pull some cash from the reserve budget. Two Capital Project Forums were held 1/21 & 1/27 and the Public Hearing was held on 2/11. Referendum vote will be Tuesday 2/25 from 2-8 pm in Mynderse Academy Lobby.
