The Year 2020 marks the 100th anniversary of the 19th Amendment. The Historical Park will recognize this anniversary with several events throughout 2020 including exhibits, presentations and youth programs.

July 17-19th -Convention days-annual commemoration of the 1848 Women's Rights Convention. This three-day event will include live performances, historic tours, children's activities, hands-on art projects and speakers. The keynote speaker will be Coline Jenkins, great-great granddaughter of Elizabeth Cady Stanton.

August 26th-Anniversary of the 19th Amendment with programs and presentations.
